OXFORDSHIRE CLUBS ROAD RELAY CHAMPIONSHIPS 2008

I am attaching entry forms for the 2008 Oxfordshire County Road Relay Championships to be held on Sunday 20th April at Hook Norton.

Because Headington Road Runners have again offered to do the results for us it would make their task a great deal easier if each club supplies a list of eligible runners on a computer file by the closing date ideally by e-mail direct. The file should be comma-delimited format (.csv) or Excell and sent to Adrienne Hopkins (ahopkins@oxfam.org.uk) It is very important that you clarify which age category each athlete is competing in - U13/U15 Boys, U13/U15 Girls (combined age group races) Sen.Men, Sen.Ladies (Over 15) Vet.Men (Over 40) and Vet Ladies (Over 35). Could I also ask that each entry follows the same format:- Surname, Name, M/F, age category, etc. and to use the same abbreviations, e.g. SM - Senior Man; VM - Veteran Man; JB - Junior Boy; SW - Senior Woman; VW - Veteran Woman; JG - Junior Girls. (For RECORD PURPOSES it would be good if you could also note the age group of each competitor: i.e. U13 or U15 girl/boy, U20, Veteran category – V35/V40 etc. etc.)

Only those athletes declared by the closing date are eligible to compete. **ANY ATHLETE THAT RUNS BUT HAS NOT BEEN DECLARED WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**

All I need, therefore is your cheque and entry form showing how many teams you are entering. The closing date for entries is **MONDAY 14TH. APRIL. NO LATE ENTRIES.** Again as previously it will be a **CONDITION OF ENTRY** that all competing clubs supply TWO NAMED HELPERS. (Please refer to Rule 4.) Please note, Clubs who wish to compete but are unable to provide 2 marshalls, can still meet their entry requirements by their runners doing marshalling duties. The 5th and 6th runners are at their allocated marshalling positions at the start of the meeting. When the first runner finishes he replaces the 5th runner (there is about an hour to do this); likewise the 2nd runner replaces the 6th. This will enable Hook Norton Harriers and Headington Road Runners to also compete in the relays.
