COUNTY QUALIFICATION/ELIGIBILITY FOR TEAM SELECTION

County qualification is gained either by birth in Oxfordshire, or by 9 months continuous residence in the County immediately prior to the competition. NOTE: (Relax Rule) All children at school in Oxon, plus all students who are not seniors or MASTerans may enter but our acceptance of these entries will not in itself establish a County qualification and such entrants cannot represent the County. They are eligible for titles and medals.

State in County Qualification overleaf either: 'Birth', 'Residence' or 'Relax'

No athlete can take part in 2 different counties championships in any one calendar year

NEW FOR 2008 - MULTI-EVENT CHAMPS

In an effort to bolster our county representation at the ESAA we are this year trialling a multi-event competition within the County Championships. Note if you tick multi events on the entry you will not be able to compete in the U17W/M events listed below*

All U15/U17/U20 athletes who wish to be included should enter all the relevant events for their age group.

All U15 athletes compete in Long Jump, Hurdles, High Jump, Shot & 800m

All U17/U20 women athletes compete in Long Jump, Hurdles, High Jump, Shot, Javelin, 200 & 800m

* U17w WILL COMPETE IN THE 200M AT A SEPARATE RACE AT THE VETS MATCH ON 19TH MAY HORSPATH 18:30

All U17 men athletes compete in Long Jump, Hurdles, High Jump, Shot, Javelin, Discus, 400 & 1500m

* U17/U20M WILL COMPETE IN SEPARATE SHOT AND 400 RACES AT THE VETS ON 19TH MAY HORSPATH 18:30

All U20 men compete in Long Jump, Hurdles, High Jump, Shot, Javelin, 400, Discus, Pole Vault, 100 & 1500m

HEATS AND FINALS

All athletes reaching a Final of any track event involving Heats must start in the final.

Failure to attend will automatically disbar the athlete from competing in any further finals that year.

RESTRICTIONS ON NUMBER OF EVENTS

U13 Boys/Girls, U15 Boys/Girls and U17 Men/Women are allowed a maximum of THREE events plus 1 Relay, on any ONE day of Competition

CLOTHING

Competitors MUST wear the vest of their affiliated Club or their School or National, Area or County association.

Numbers should be pinned side to side or all four corners.

MEDALS

Medals not collected at the Championships **will not** be sent by post, unless requested.

All Master aged athletes will compete in 10 year bands i.e. Women 35-44, 45-54 etc Men 40-49, 50-59 etc

e.g. 1x40, 1x50, 2x60 men discus - award would be 3 gold medals

CANCELLATION OF EVENTS

The Championship Committee reserve the right to cancel any events for which there are insufficient entries.

COUNTY TEAM SELECTION

County teams will be primarily selected from those competing in the Championships but team managers do have authority to agree exceptions. This needs to be agreed PRIOR to the Championships if athletes are unable to compete.

County Champions earn automatic selection.

INTER-COUNTY MEETINGS 2008

The first 3 athletes in the finals should complete a County availability form. This will be issued at the medal presentation.
